AIMS

- Enable students to share their experience of living in small towns
- Make them think of what makes a city European
- Enable them to learn about other small towns in Europe

WORK PROCESS

Nov 2017 - May 2018

- Present yourself and your favorite European city
- Brainstorming around the characteristics of a European town
- Present your town and how European it is (national teams)
- Creation of a song about Europe and small towns (collaborative writing)
- Creation of international teams (What do you like to do on vacation?)
- Creation of a thematically travel itinerary for a tour of Europe's small towns: for example, an extreme sports travel plan (international groups)

RESULTS

 Creation of a tour guide of Europe's small towns (digital book which regroups all of the travel itinerary)
